- Steak and Cumbrian Ale pie with chunks of beef in a Jennings Ale gravy
- Slow-cooked lamb joint with grain mustard mash and a rosemary jus
- Pan-fried breast of chicken with mushroom and red wine gravy
- Cod and pancetta fish cake with crisp leaves and sweet chili sauce
- Pan-fried Scottish salmon with a white wine dill cream sauce
- Pan-fried fillet of trout with new potatoes, roast cherry tomatoes and a balsamic glaze
- Roast loin of Cumbrian pork with apple and thyme stuffing, apple sauce and a red wine glaze
- Roast sirloin of Lakeland beef, traditional Yorkshire puddings, horseradish cream with a rich pan gravy
- Homemade Jennings Ale-battered cod, mushy peas and lemon, with homemade tartare sauce
- All served with seasonal vegetables and potatoes
