Single vineyard, hand-crafted Champagne from Jean Pierre Marniquet . A classic, elegant wine, delicate, dry with a crisp flavour and fresh lemony aroma. Alc. 12%
- 2. Moët et Chandon Brut** **NV** **£49**  
The best selling non-vintage Champagne. It is consistently soft, fresh and very well balanced. Alc. 12%
- 3. Veuve Clicquot** **NV** **£60**  
The predominance of Pinot Noir provides the structure that is so typically Clicquot, while Chardonnay adds elegance and finesse in a perfectly balanced wine. Alc. 12%
- 4. Bollinger Special Cuvee** **NV** **£58**  
Lovely classy, intense nose shows savoury yeasty notes and a touch of lifted acidity, with a complex toasty edge.
- 5. J.P. Marniquet Reserve Brut** **NV** **£38**  
Single vineyard, hand-crafted Champagne from Jean Pierre Marniquet . A classic, elegant wine, delicate, dry with a crisp flavour and fresh lemony aroma. This wine contains only juice from the first pressing. Alc. 12%

**6. Gosset Grande Reserve** **NV** **£57**  
Oldest Champagne House in France, producing outstanding rich quality wine.  
Alc12%

**7. J.P. Marniquet Carte d'Or Brut Magnum NV** **£74**  
Single vineyard, hand-crafted Champagne from Jean Pierre Marniquet . A classic, elegant wine, delicate, dry with a crisp flavour and fresh lemony aroma.. Alc. 12%

**8. Dom Perignon** **1998/2000** **£115**  
Dom Perignon is only produced in the finest vintages from grapes grown on 100% rated vineyards Acacia honey and fresh almonds on the nose whilst dried apricots and toasted brioche combine on the long finish.

**9. Marniquet Cuvee Rosé** **NV** **£40**  
A dry and crisp refreshing champagne. Sparkling elegant red fruit flavour. Alc. 12%

**10. Laurent Perrier Rosé** **NV** **£92**  
Champagne Laurent Perrier Rose Brut is the most famous rosé With flavours of strawberry, cherry, biscuit, cinnamon toast, and mint. Aged at least 4 years on its lees,. Alc. 12%

variety grown at the Fonthill glebe vineyard in Wiltshire

Med dry wine made from the Seyval Blanc and Muller Thurgau  
grape varieties grown at Teffiont Evias , Salisbury, Wiltshire  
Alc.10.5%

Top Chablis from this small Domain, made with 100% Chardonnay. This particular example shows a delightful freshness and length of flavour.

A first growth Chablis of fresh and delicate style. Alc 13%
- 18. Bourgogne Chardonnay 2007** **£25**  
**Vieilles Vignes**  
The vineyards for this wine are situated both in the Côte d'Or and the Hautes-Côtes regions of Burgundy. The selection of older vines and oak aging gives us a wine that is both balanced and complex
- 19. Bourgogne Chardonnay 2005** **£44**  
**Vieilles Vignes Magnum**  
The selection of older vines and oak aging gives us a wine that is both balanced and complex
- 20. Macon Lugny Chalonaise 2009** **£25**  
A fine fresh dry white from Louis Latour, with an elegant lemony nose, sharp fruit flavours and finish. Alc. 13.5%
- 21. Pouilly Fuisse Chalonaise 2009** **£28**  
A wine with fine nose, subtle and open. Ripe fruit, floral art. It is round and well balanced. Can be enjoyed as an aperitif, it will perfectly entries, a pike, the prawns, scallops of Jacques, sweetbreads and white meat in cream sauce.
- 22. Puligny Montrachet Côte de Beaune 2007** **£4.00.**  
Rich, open, gentle, very relaxed and almost creamy in style, buttery and full with a long after taste .
- 23. Meursault Côte de Beaune 2006** **£59**  
**Premier Cru Les Charmes**  
Meursault One of the world's greatest whites. Savoury, rich smoothness, dry, slightly nutty flavour and long, mellow finish. Great finesse and balance, with lemon, vanilla and almond flavours. 13%vol.

## Loire

**24. Muscadet de Sevre Et Maine 2009** £22  
Pleasant white wine with mild fruit and acidity

**25. Vouvray La Fereine 2007** £22  
Medium soft wine from the middle of the Loire, just east of Tours, with good fruit and soft honeyed finish.

**26. Sancerre Paul Vattan 2008** £28  
“Pente de Maimbray” French classic, made from 100% Sauvignon Blanc.  
Dry and crisp with fresh acidity, gooseberry nose with a slight flinty edge.  
Perfect! Alc. 12.5%

**27. Pouilly Fume 2009** £29  
Intense nose exhaling the citrus fruits, pineapple and mango. Round and well-structured mouth, that confirms the elegance and the richness of aromas, with an acidulous finish.

## Alsace

**29. Riesling Pinot Gris 2005** £26  
Wonderful blend of these two grape varieties making a very refreshing, quite aromatic medium bodied wine. Stunning on its own but really goes well with all white fish and shellfish dishes. 12.5% vol.

**30. Pfaffenheim Pinot Blanc 2007** £27  
Pinot blanc goes well with starters, asparagus, onion tarts, quiches, baby rabbits, sweets after the cheese and fruit before.

**31. Pfaffenheim Pinot Gris 2007** £25  
This heady white wine can be substituted for a red with meat dishes, a plate of cold meat, country pâté, roasts, game and poultry. Alc 13.5%

**32. Pfaffenheim Gewürztraminer 2009** £27  
Full of character and personality. Intense and complex nose.  
Spicy, sweet, exotic, perfumed fruit - pineapple, lychees, hints of wax, balanced by mouth-watering acidity. Alc 13.5%

## South of France

- 28. Viognier Vin de Pays 2008** **£20**  
Good aromatic nose, typical of the grape, fresh bouquet. Alc 14%

## Italy

- 34. Pinot Grigio Ca Solare Lombardy 2009** **£22**  
A medium wine with a good fruit concentration showing an appealing caramel flavour.

- 35. Orvieto Classico Amabile Umbria 2007** **£25**  
Bright gold in colour, strong bouquet of wild flowers, honey and musk with a hint of bitter almonds, sweet to the palate, soft, fresh flavour with a delightful aftertaste of ripe fruit.

- 36. Soave Costeggialo Veneto 2008** **£27**  
This is a single estate wine, showing classic crisp almond notes, together with hints of citrus, apples and marzipan on the nose. Alc. 12.5%

## Spain

- 37. Rioja Vega Blanco Rioja 2008** **£24**  
A modern style winery in Rioja, producing this fruity white wine. Alc. 13%

- 38. Albarino Vionta Galicia 2008** **£30**  
Spain's most exciting white grape variety from Rias Baixas Galicia, crisp fresh and delicious, a stunning zingy fruity wine with lots of fruity attack. Alc 12.5%

## Portugal

- 39. Esporao Portugal Alentejo 2007** **£29**  
Rich full bodied dry white wine with depth and complexity, aged in new French and American oak barrels.

## Germany

**40. Riesling Kabinett 2008 £16.95**  
This delicate, moderately light bodied Riesling has a tasteful, granny smith apple characteristic that is crisp and lively on the palate.

**41. Piesporter Michelsberg Mosel 2009 £17.95**  
Hints of peaches and green apples are balanced perfectly with crisp acidity to provide a clean and fresh finish. Ideal by itself or to complement a variety of meat and seafood dishes. Alc 9%

**42. Oppenheimer Krottenbrunnen Spatlese 2009 £22**  
Rheinhessen Spatlese – A delicious medium sweet white wine  
Alc. 10.5%

**43. Dr Loosen Riesling Mosel 2009 £22**  
Typical high quality Mosel Riesling, demonstrating the wonderful harmony of fruit and acidity that makes Riesling arguably the finest white wine grape in the world. Alc 8.5%

**44. Oppenheimer Herrenburg Auslese 2005 £33**  
An opulent wine from the Rheinhessen. Complex evolving aromas of spice, marmalade and super-ripe tropical fruit carry on to the palate, with excellent acidity to balance. Alc 8.5%

## Austria

**45. Riesling Maximilian Burgenland 2006 £18**  
Dry Riesling complex and slight notes of petrol and hazelnuts.

## California

**46. Ironstone Viognier 2005 £27**

Classic yet refined Viognier has a tropical bouquet of white peaches with a hint of honeysuckle. Its intriguing aroma gives way to rich mango with subtle notes of lychee fruit.

## Chile

**47. La Lejania Sauvignon Blanc Maule 2010 £16.95**

Fresh and clean with typical varietal flavours of cut grass and asparagus. Alc. 12%

**48. Cordillera Chardonnay Curicó 2008 £28**

A generous nose, apple and hazelnut fruit aromas, complemented by fine nuances of toasted bread and vanilla. A very special Chardonnay from the Miguel Torres stable of wines. Alc. 14%

**49. Sauvignon Blanc Torres Curicó 2009 £24**

From the Curicó valley, Chile's most southerly wine region, a fresh floral wine with clean gooseberry fruity tones and a crisp acidity. Alc. 13%

**50. Reserve Chardonnay La Lejania 2010 £18**

This wine has benefited from a short period of oak-aging, resulting in a richer wine full of peachy nuances. Alc. 13.5%

## Argentina

**51. Suspiro Torrontes Mendoza 2005 £20**

Tropical fruits are foremost in a wonderful array of rich and complex flavours from this blend of Torrontes and Chardonnay.

## South Africa

**52. Chenin Blanc Franschhoek 2010 £22**

There is lots of fresh lemon and lime that crisps up the tropical fruit. The mid palate is sweeter with hints of apricot. It is fresh easy uncomplicated and has nice length.

**53. Sauvignon Blanc Robertson 2010 £24**

from Bon Courage this is a crisp and fruity dry white wine with lots of gooseberry and tropical flavours, good depth and a long finish. Alc 13%

**55. Chenin Blanc Stellenbosch 2009 £24**

Wines of Good Hope, Stellenbosch. Pale yellow with lots of exotic flavours. Full flavour in the mouth with enticing freshness. An excellent Chenin blanc with lots of class. Alc 13.9%

**56. Radford Dale Chardonnay Stellenbosch 2006 £36**

A Stellenbosch Chardonnay daring to be individual, focused on backbone, not butter. With wonderful fruit complexity on the nose and lingering lime minerality on the palate. Alc 13.9%

## Australia

**57. Semillon Chardonnay 2010 £24**

Aldridge estate from **Riverina** South Eastern Australia this delightful crisp and fruity wine is a result of a blend of Trophy Winning Semillon and oak-matured Chardonnay to produce a well balanced full flavoured wine. Alc 13%

**58. Mitchells Watervale Riesling 2008 £27**

From the Clare valley. Intense aromatic Riesling fruit flavours are the hallmarks of this wine. It has a fine dry palate with a crisp acidity and a long lingering fruit finish. Alc 13.5 %

**59. Simon Hackett Chardonnay 2009 £25**

South Australia. A classic dry white wine with distinctive, powerful varietal flavours and subtle oak. Alc 13.5%

**60. Mitchells Semillon Clare Valley 2006 £27**

Subtle French oak handling - both during fermentation and initial aging - serves to complement the stylishly tangy fruit in this Clare Valley wine. The palate is clean, fresh and with crisp acidity.  
Alc 13%

**61. Sauvignon Semillon Karri Oak 2008 £23**

A classic Western Australian dry white wine blend. These two grape varieties combine to produce a wonderful crisp easy drinking wine style, with hints of musk, white peach and passion fruit.

## **New Zealand**

**62. Sauvignon Blanc lake Chalice 2009 £28**

Classic Marlborough Sauvignon, lovely intense, fresh piercing fruit, grapefruit, asparagus and gooseberry. Crisp, clean and refreshing

**63. Chardonnay CJ Pask Hawks Bay 2009 £27**

Intense citrus and grapefruit characters, with creamy oak.  
A fresh, fruit driven Chardonnay enhanced with sweet creamy oak and fine texture.

**64. Pinot Gris Lake Chalice Marlborough 2007 £33**

Fully dry but finely balanced, with a scented bouquet of pears and spices, Fresh crisp flavours combine well with the wine's slightly oily texture. Alc. 13%

**65. Alpha Domus Viognier 2008 £33**

This is a well balanced Hawks bay wine with fresh acidity and a lingering sweet fruit finish has a delicate and complex aroma of rose petals

## Rose Wines

**66. Syrah Rosé France vdp 2009 £20**

Domaine du Bosc Languedoc Roussillon A light, fresh and fruity wine. Bright and sunny in character, it is especially enjoyable in summer as an aperitif or with pasta, salads or cold meats.

**67. Rioja Vega Rosado Spain Rioja 2009 £24**

Made from Garnacha grapes. Intense raspberry pink, fresh and bright. Very well balanced, lively and cheerful. Alc 12.5%

**68. Cabernet Sauvignon Rosé Chile 2010 £22**

A beautiful pale cherry colour. The aroma is concentrated and powerful, reminiscent of plums and strawberries. The aftertaste is long and smooth, with excellent balance.

**69. Le Lejania Merlot Chile Maule 2010 £16.95**

Stunning strawberries on the nose. Ideal for a sunny afternoon. Alc. 13.5%

**70. Merlot Rosé New Zealand 2009 £28**

Instinct Rosé from Acclaimed wine maker Kate Radburnd a great Rosé from Hawkes Bay in New Zealand. Using some of the best grapes from the area to produce an elegant rose with fresh fruit aromas. A serious rosé alc 13%

**71. Pinot Grigio Rosé Ca Solare Lombardy 2010 £20**

A medium wine with a good fruit concentration showing an appealing light fruity flavour.

**72. Château Bellevue La Forêt 2007 £25**

From the Fronton area of France just north of Toulouse a blend of Negrette, Syrah and Gamay with a floral and Cherry nose.

## Beaujolais

- 73. Château de Varennes 2009** **£22**  
From the commune of Quincie in Beaujolais Villages. Soft purple red in colour with rich raspberryfruit on the nose and good length on the palate. Alc 12.5%
- 74. Fleurie Domaine de la Viroylette 2009** **£25**  
Fleurie is still the best known and most popular of the 10 individual Beaujolais Villages, which make up the appellation. This fruity scented wine from Jacques Charlet is one of the lighter wines, lively and clean. Alc 13%
- 75. Regnie Domaine de Colette 2004** **£28**  
Regnie has a very low tannin level and is fabulous with chicken, veal, roast pork, sausages, terrines and hot hors d'œuvre, cheeses and mushroom-based vegetarian dishes.

## Burgundy

- 76. Mercurey Côte Chalonnaise 2006** **£35**  
Domaine Faiveley A beautiful dark ruby colour. The nose opens up with notes of fresh red fruits and spices. Pleasant to taste, this wine has a round and fruity attack before revealing its fine and silky tannins.
- 77. Savigny-les-Beaune Côte de Beaune 2005** **£38**  
Albert Bichot Consistent quality with wonderful purity of fruit. Alc 13%
- 78. Chassagne Montrachet Côte de Beaune 2008** **£34**  
Albert Bichot Excellent Pinot Noir flavours, from one of the great winemakers of Burgundy. Alc 13%
- 79. Pommard Côte de Beaune 2001** **£49**  
Croix Blanche Domaine Parent. Beautiful Pinot Noir from a top Burgundy producer. Full-bodied, yet soft and well-balanced fruit on the palate. Alc 13%
- 80. Bourgogne Pinot Noir Vieilles Vignes 2007** **£24**  
This is a bright garnet red wine, fresh with a delicate fruitiness of cherry (sweet), plum and a touch of spice. Alc 13%

**81. Bourgogne Pinot Noir Vieilles Vignes 2003** **£51**  
**MAGNUM**

This is a bright garnet red wine, fresh with a delicate fruitiness of cherry (sweet), plum and a touch of spice. It is tender and soft, from gentle oak-aging, with a pleasant tannic background. Alc 13%

**82. Gevrey-Chambertin 2006 Côte de Nuits** **£50**  
Albert Bichot .Delicate flavours showing the excellent Pinot Noir grape at its best. Alc 13%

**83. Nuits StGeorges Côte de Nuits 2004** **£57**  
Albert Bichot Rich, dark, velvety. Burgundy as it should be. Alc 13%

### **Frontonnais**

**84. Château Bellevue La Forêt 2007** **£25**  
From Fronton just north of Toulouse a very intense of pepper and blackcurrants made from a blend of Negrette, Syrah, Cabernet sauvignon and Cabernet franc. Alc 13%

### **Bordeaux**

**85. Château Le Preuil Medoc 2004** **£29**  
A beautiful ruby colour in the typical Medoc style ( 65% Cabernet Sauvignon 35% Merlot). This wine displays elegant tannins with a hint of oak ageing. Alc. 13%

**86. Château Malbat 2008 Bordeaux Superieur** **£20**  
From this excellent petit château from the south-east part of Bordeaux, comes this medium-bodied, easy-drinking claret, full of soft fruit flavours.

**87. Château Vieux Negrit 2007** **£25**  
**Montagne Saint Emilion** A red colour with ruby tints. Nice balance between hints of fruit (wild strawberries) and peppery touches.

- 89. Château d'Agassac 2002 Haut Medoc** **£34**  
 Ruby and purple tints with red fruit aromas and plums and an elegant oaky touch. Full bodied with velvety tannins, an elegant 13%vol.
- 90. Sellan Grand Cru 2003 St Emilion** **£38**  
 Second wine of Chateau Vieux Fortin taking the name of the owner Claude Sellan. A complex deep satisfying wine. Alc. 12.5%
- 91. Château Faugères 2002** **£46**  
**Saint-Emilion Grand Cru** Expressive and complex bouquet of red fruit and liquorice full bodied and graceful stunning wine
- 92. Château Lagrange 1999 Pomerol** **£55**  
 This small property located on the famous plateau of Pomerol and is owned by Jean-Pierre MOUEIX. vines grow on a heavy clay soil on which the predominant Merlot grape shows its full character, round, supple.
- 93. Château Tour Saint Fort St Estephe 1999** **£52**  
 Intense nose of blackcurrant and plums. Full bodied with ripe tannins. The oak is well integrated into the wine. Alc 13%
- 94. Château Terrey Gros Cailloux St Julien 2002** **£50**  
 Cru Bourgeois St Julien. The depth, balance and complexity of the 2000, which is now 'opening out' beautifully belies its Cru Bourgeois status. Alc. 12.5%
- 95. Château Montgravey Margaux 2005** **£50**  
 Intense nose of blackcurrant and plums. Full bodied with ripe tannins. The oak is well integrated into the wine. Alc 13%
- 96. Château Soussans 2004 Margaux** **£45**  
 Margaux located in the heart of Médoc 30km north varieties : 50% Cabernet Sauvignon and 50% Merlot giving full bodied really well structured Claret.
- 97. Château La Fleur Milon Pauillac 2003** **£52**

This area is located on a land of high quality, close to Chateau Mouton Rothschild and Chateau Clerc Milon adjoins. Its terroir, situated on gravelly ridges of Pauillac is remarkable for its serious drainage.

## Rhône

- 99. Cotes du Rhône Rhône 2008 £19**  
Domaine de Verquieres - A fine example of what is possible when organically grown grapes and intelligent wine making combine. An elegant, medium-bodied wine, which will complement game and rich meat dishes. Alc 13.0%
- 100. Sablet - Côtes du Rhône Villages 2006 £22**  
Grenache grapes bring roundness and suppleness. Syrah grapes give colour and aroma. Cinsault grapes give aroma and balance. Mouvèdre grapes bring body and complexity.. Alc 13.5%
- 101. Rasteau - Côtes du Rhône Villages 2006 £22**  
With a deep colour, the nose discloses scents of truffle and quince. Powerful on the palate, this wine fits in a scenario dominated by pride and generosity. Alc 13.5%
- 102. Vacqueras 2007 £29**  
Domaine de Verquieres - Wonderful wine from the pretty little village of Vacqueyras. Made from Grenache and Syrah this full-bodied wine has underlying powerful fruit from the Grenache with gentle spice from the Syrah. Alc 13.5%
- 103. Crozes Hermitage Pradelle 2007 £28**  
Syrah 100% with 12 months in oak barrels gives red berries ,pepper spice game and ripe fruit.
- 104. Chateaunuef du Pape 2005 Rhône £40**  
“The 2004 Chateauneuf du Pape has outstanding richness, a big, sexy bouquet of roasted herbs, tobacco leaf, sweet jammy cherries and raspberries mixed with some truffle, liquorice, and earth.

## South of France

**105. Montpeyroux 2004 Languedoc £20**

Domaine de la Croix du Sud beautiful deep red, the nose expresses both notes of ripe fruit Blackberries, blueberries spices pepper, juniper and notes of flints.

**Alsace**

**106. Pinot Noir 2008 £28**

Attractive ruby colour with discreet garnet tints. red berry aromas (strawberry, raspberry), with some notes of vanilla. This wine is fresh and pleasant on the finish, with fruity and slightly toasted aromas.

**Italy**

**107. Montepeluciano D'Abruzzo 2009 £21**

This typical wine from the Abruzzo region has a deep colour and full bodied taste with a well balanced tannic finish.

**108. Chianti 2007 Tuscany £25**

Part of the wine spends a brief period in new oak casks, made from Allier and Cher which makes the wine spicy with perfumes of cherries and flowers, especially violets.

**109. Valpolicella Classico Rizzardi Veneto 2009 £27**

This wine is exclusively produced from grapes coming from the Guerrieri Rizzardi vineyards. A hint of oak on the nose, morello cherry and leather notes on the palate. Alc. 12%

**110. Dogajolo Toscano Rosso 2007 £29**

Deep garnet with violet reflections, very fruity and intense, with hints of cherry, coffee, vanilla and spice.

**111. Rosso Toscano Traluna 2008 £27**

97% Sangiovese and 3% Alicante Buchet Brilliant deep ruby with violet shades spicy, dark berries, roasted aromas, vanilla. Powerful but still elegant, 13.5% Vol.

**112. Barolo 2005 Piedmont £43**

A Big wine with garnet colour with orange hues intense scent of red fruit and violets. The taste is full, wide and velvety with a finish of spices and a hint of vanilla.

## Spain

**113. Tempranillo Allozo 2006 La Mancha £22**

Aged in oak for twelve months, this dark cherry red wine with tinges of terracotta has aromas of spices and mature black fruits. Full-bodied and silky on the palate. 13%vol.

**114. Rioja Vega Crianza 2007 Rioja £24**

aged for twelve months in oak casks, followed by at least a further six months in the bottle. The result is a complex wine, rich in aromas and flavours. Clean, bright ruby red with aromas of vanilla, toast and spices.

**115. Laguna de la Nava 2001 Valdepenas £26**

Gran Reserva from Valdepenas. A wonderfully rich and smooth red wine, made from the Tempranillo grape, with delicious elegant vanilla flavours. Alc 13%

**116. Rioja Vega Reserva 2005 Rioja £28**

Full of fruit with jammy and plummy flavours, lots of body, softness and character. Wine with a tremendous bouquet, beautifully balanced. Alc 13.5%

**117. Rioja Vega Crianza 2003 Rioja Magnum £52**

Full of fruit with jammy and plummy flavours, lots of body, softness and character. Wine with a tremendous bouquet, beautifully balanced.  
Alc 13.5%

**118. Rioja Gran Reserva Salceda 2000 Rioja £40**

Full attack. Harmonious and elegant. Pleasant balance and a good structure. Long. Aromatic aftertaste of clove and nutmeg.

## **Portugal**

**119. Tuella 2008 Douro £23**

From the Symington Family estates, a deep plummy red with ripe black fruit characteristics, herbs and spices and unmistakable aromas of fresh earth - typical of good wines from the Douro valley. "This wine looks like port in the glass...a really concentrated jammy finish. Alc. 13%

**120. Esporao 2005 Alentejo £32**

## **Austria**

**121. Pinot Noir Maximilian Hof Burgenland 2006 £23**

An outstanding example of this internationally famous Grape variety. Lovely aromatic bouquet that is Pinot with an almost vegetal, farmyard rustic feel to this Wine. A real Must for any Pinot enthusiast.

## **Argentina**

**122. Malbec Sol de Mayo Mendoza 2008 £23**

Malbec doesn't have the blackcurranty fruitiness of Cabernet; rather it is a bit darker, and a little more savoury, with spice and earthy undertones..

**123. Pampas Pinot Noir Mendoza 2009 £16.50**

Very pleasant Pinot noir fresh fruity and little tannins . Quite a complex wine and a very good example of the grape that also produces red burgundies.

## Chile

**124. Cabernet Sauvignon 2008 £25**

**Santa Digna Curicó** A clear ruby colour with spicy liquorice and blackcurrant flavours typical of the variety, and boasting a lazy, elegant aftertaste. A product of the Miguel Torres family. 13.5%vol.

**125. La Lejania Reserve Merlot Maule 2010 £16.95**

A ripe fruity wine with woodland overtones and a smokey background. Alc. 13.0%

**126. La Lejania Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 £16.95**

from the Maule region A ripe fruity wine with woodland overtones and a Smokey background. Alc. 13.0%

**127. Carmen Campo D'oro Carmenère 2008 £23**

**132. Cabernet Merlot 2006 Western Australia** **£24**

From Western Australia this is a wine with distinctive ripe blackcurrant and plum aromas. Made from a blend of approximately 80% Cabernet and 20% With a light touch of oak. Alc 14%

**133. Tamar Ridge Pinot Noir 2005 Tasmania** **£37**

Ripe flavours of dark plum, mulberry and loganberry dominate the front of the palate and flow through to a finish with fine, silky tannins

## **New Zealand**

**134. Lake Chalice Pinot Noir 2008** **£31**

From Marlborough Red plum and cherry dominate the palate which is supported by fine grained oak tannins and nuances of red currant and forest floor.

**135. C J Pask Declaration Merlot 2007 Hawks Bay** **£36**

Warm and ripe, with complex brambly Merlot fruits. Layers of flavours, good tannin and extract, supported by mouth filling texture and fine oak.

### **161. Gewurztraminer 2006 Alsace £16**

Full of character and personality. Intense and complex nose. Spicy, sweet, exotic, perfumed fruit - pineapple, lychees, hints of wax, balanced by mouth-watering acidity. Alc 13.5%

### **162. Maçon Blanc Village 2008 Burgundy £16**

Dry white elegant Chalonaise wine from the Chardonnay grape
