The addition of a new lakeside marquee means the hotel can now accommodate parties with up to 200 guests.





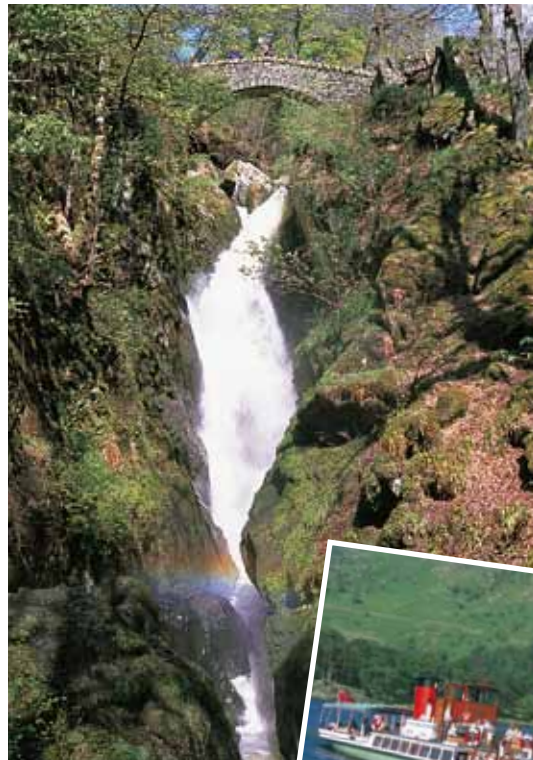
# Enjoy a tour of the area

Step outside and the scenery will take your breath away. Whether you are here for walking, touring or just relaxing there is something for everyone. Many of the Lake District's most famous walks have their starting points around Ullswater and they all lead through stunning countryside, where discoveries await – from cascading waterfalls at Aira Force to herds of wild red deer and the occasional red squirrel.

If you prefer something a little more relaxed, then the Ullswater steamers, just 5 minutes walk from the hotel, provide an alternative mode of transport around the lake.

Dalemain Historic House and Gardens with its agricultural and countryside collections and delightful walks, and the Rheged Centre, Europe's largest earth covered centre, are only a short drive away.

When touring the Lake District, why not stop at The Inn on the Lake for refreshments? We welcome groups from early morning to late. Enjoy meals in the restaurant, or afternoon tea on the terrace. In the winter we serve mulled wine and mince pies in the lounge. Whatever the time of year, the Inn on the Lake provides warm hospitality.

There is an abundance of different activities in the area, such as rock climbing, pony trekking, mountain biking and fishing. The hotel also has its own outdoor activities including pitch & putt and croquet.

There is a children's play area but if you want to explore further afield you can make use of our free bike hire.

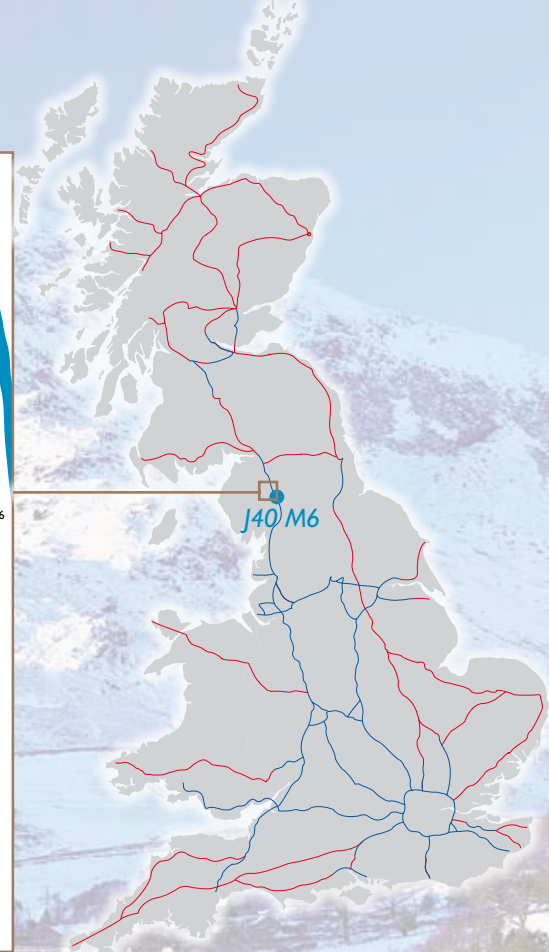
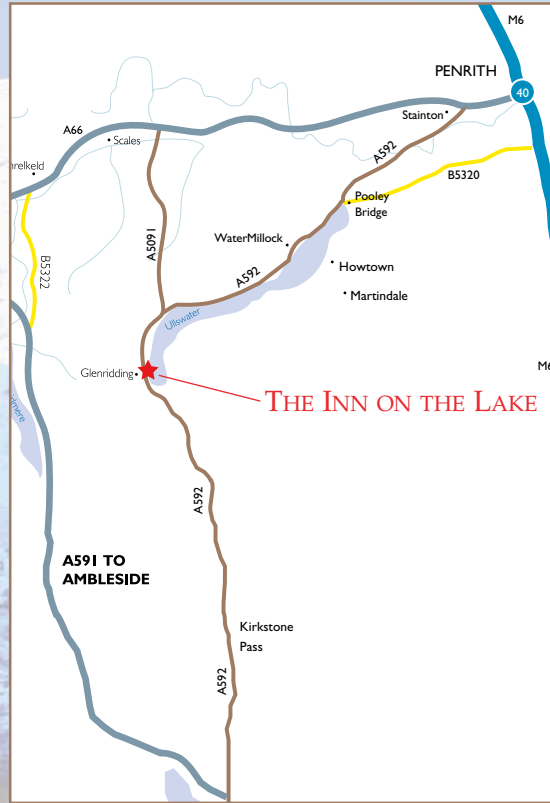
Various watersports can be arranged from the hotel's 3 private jetties, while for the less energetic, the Ullswater Steamer provides an alternative mode of transport around the lake.

In the hotel's leisure suite you can exercise in the gym or unwind in the sauna and jacuzzi.



The hotel is only 12 miles from J40 on the M6. From the motorway, exit onto A66 towards Keswick. At the first roundabout, by the Rheged Discovery Centre, take the A592 towards Ullswater and then follow the shoreline of Lake Ullswater to Glenridding village.

Travelling from Windermere, take the A591 towards Ambleside and turn right at Troutbeck, following the A592 down into Glenridding. The hotel is 300 miles from London, 120 miles from Edinburgh and 100 miles from Manchester - easily accessed by rail with the nearest mainline station at Penrith.
