## **CHAMPAGNE**

**1 J.P. Marniquet Carte d'Or Brut - NV\* £ 38.50**

Single vineyard, hand-crafted Champagne from Jean Pierre Marniquet . A classic, elegant wine, delicate, dry with a crisp flavour and fresh lemony aroma. This wine contains only juice from the first pressing. Alc. 12.0%

**2 Moët et Chandon Brut - NV £ 49.00**

The world's best selling non-vintage Champagne. It is consistently soft, fresh and very well-balanced. Alc. 12.0%

**3 Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut - NV £ 59.50**

The predominance of Pinot Noir provides the structure that is so typically Clicquot, while Chardonnay adds elegance and finesse in a perfectly balanced wine. Alc. 12.0%

**4 Bollinger Grande Annee - 2000 £ 85.00**

La Grande Annee is Bollinger's Prestige Cuvee and is only produced in exceptional vintages. Intensely rich, with a biscuit, yeasty nose. Powerful flavours of toasted nuts, wild fruits and crème brûlée, balanced with lively acidity. Alc. 12.0%

### **MAGNUM OF CHAMPAGNE (150 cl.)**

**5 J.P. Marniquet Reserve Brut - NV £ 74.50**

Single vineyard, hand-crafted Champagne from Jean Pierre Marniquet. A classic, elegant wine, delicate, dry with a crisp flavour and a fresh lemony aroma. This wine contains only juice from the first pressing. Alc. 12.0%

## ROSÉ CHAMPAGNE

**6 Marniquet Cuvee Rosé - NV £ 42.00**

A dry and crisp refreshing champagne. Sparkling elegant red fruit flavour. Alc. 12.0%

**7 Laurent Perrier Rosé - NV £ 74.00**

Champagne Laurent Perrier Rose Brut is the most famous rosé with crisp acidity and light tannins. Medium/full in body, it offers aromas and flavours of strawberry, cherry, biscuit, cinnamon toast, and mint. Aged at least 4 years on its lees, it is most complex, with a lingering finish. Alc. 12.0%

## SPARKLING WINE

**8 Cava Portaceli Brut - NV\* £ 19.75**

An elegant sparkling wine from the Penedes region of Catalonia, in the north-east corner of Spain. Alc. 12.0%

**9 Pinot Grigio Rose Spumante Brut - NV £ 24.00**

A copper pink rosé from Northern Italy's Pavia region, showing gentle fragrant summer fruits on the nose with delicate strawberry flavours. Alc. 12.5%

**10 Bon Courage Cap Classique Brut - 2004 £ 29.00**

Noble Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes provide the ingredients for this classy Cap Classique wine, made following the traditional "Champagne" method and only released after three years of careful cellar maturation. Aromas with peace and hints of citrus. Rich creamy flavours with a lively mousse which awakens the palate. An excellent New World sparkling wine with a crisp lingering finish. To enjoy as an aperitif or with all types of food – a wine for all occasions. Alc. 12.0%

## **BORDEAUX - RED WINE**

### **11 Château Malbat - 2009 £ 19.75**

From this excellent petit château from the south-east part of Bordeaux, comes this medium-bodied, easy-drinking claret, full of soft fruit flavours. Alc. 13.0%

### **12 Château Gasquerie - 2009 £ 26.50**

Now benefiting from a little maturity this wine is reaching its peak. The plummy fruit aromas have been joined by developed notes of coffee and toast. The palate still has a vibrancy of cassis and black fruits with a little vanilla spice to the finish. A real Sunday roast wine, spring lamb or roast beef. Alc. 13.0%

### **13 Chateau Sellan - 2003 £ 37.00**

Second wine of Chateau Vieux Fortin taking the name of the owner Claude Sellan. A complex deep satisfying wine. Alc. 12.5%

### **14 La Reserve Leoville Barton - 2004 £ 57.50**

Cru Bourgeois St Julien. This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> wine from one of Bordeaux's finest chateaux. The depth, balance and complexity of the 2004, is now 'opening out' beautifully. Alc. 12.5%

### **15 Château Batailley - 5<sup>Th</sup> growth Pauillac - 2004 £ 70.00**

This is a stylish vintage in the Bordeaux, possessing less richness than the great 2000's, but showing great purity of fruit and minerality. This is approaching maturity, displaying classic cassis and cedar-wood aromas, and would partner roast lamb beautifully. Alc. 12.5%

### **16 Château Bellevue La Foret - Rosé - 2010 £ 23.50**

This chateau in the Fronton area, south west of Bordeaux, came on stream in 1974 with the objective to produce red and rose wines exclusively from Cabernet France, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Gamay Noir and Negrette, a grape variety indigenous here. The alluvial and well drained soil of the appellation and mild climate help produce fruit eminently suitable for fine rose, which is refreshing, with good acidity, fruit and balance. Alc. 12.5%

## **BURGUNDY - WHITE WINE**

- 20 Bourgogne Chardonnay Vieilles Vignes - 2007\*      £ 23.00**  
**21 Bourgogne Chardonnay Vieilles Vignes Magnum      £ 44.00**

The vineyards for this wine are situated both in the Côte d'Or and the Hautes-Côtes regions of Burgundy. The selection of older vines and oak aging gives us a wine that is both balanced and complex. Alc. 13.0%

- 22 Macon Lugny - 2009      £ 28.00**

A fine fresh dry white from Louis Latour, with an elegant      lemony nose, sharp fruit flavours and finish. Alc. 13.5%

- 23 Chablis Domaine Manants - 2009      £ 29.50**

Top Chablis from this small Domaine, made with 100% Chardonnay. This particular example shows a delightful      freshness and length of flavour. Alc. 12.5%

- 24 Chablis 1<sup>er</sup> Cru Fourchaume - 2008      £ 39.50**

Fourchaume is one of the largest and most recognized vineyards in Chablis. With a west/southwest exposure, it produces wines with distinct qualities : they are floral and fruity, yet possessing minerality and delicacy. This wines is complex and rich. Alc. 13.0%

- 25 Puligny Montrachet Bichot - 2007      £ 44.50**

The style of Puligny-Montrachet is often very mineral, with a more restrained oak character and tends to be described as "elegant" rather than fruit-driven. This is the epitome of fine Chardonnay, from one of the most famous vineyard sites in the world.  
Alc. 13.0%

## **BURGUNDY - RED WINE**

**30 Beaujolais Villages – 2009 £ 22.00**

Château de Varennes. Soft purple red in colour with rich raspberry fruit on the nose and good length on the palate. Alc 12.5%

**31 Fleurie Domaine de La Viroylette - 2009 £ 28.50**

Fleurie is still the best known and most popular of the 10 individual Beaujolais Villages, which make up the appellation. This fruity scented wine from Jacques Charlet is one of the lighter wines, lively and clean. Alc. 13.0%

**32 Bourgogne Pinot Noir Vieilles Vignes - 2007\* £ 26.00**

**33 Bourgogne Pinot Noir Vieilles Vignes Magnum £ 50.00**

This is a bright garnet red wine, fresh with a delicate fruitiness of cherry (sweet), plum and a touch of spice. It is tender and soft, from gentle oak-aging, with a pleasant tannic background. Alc. 13.0%

**34 Cote de Beaune Albert Bichot - 2007 £ 32.00**

It has a deep, bright ruby-red colour. Elegant, and has aromas of black berries, sweet spices and a certain minerality . Fleshy and big flavours, underlined by new oak. Alc 13.0%

**35 Gevry Chambertin - 2006 £ 39.00**

A full-bodied wine from the Cote de Nuits, offering richness and finesse. Alc. 13%

**36 Pommard Croix Blanche - 2001 £ 45.00**

Domaine Parent. Beautiful Pinot Noir from a top Burgundy producer. Full-bodied, yet soft and well-balanced fruit on the palate. Alc. 13.0%

## **LOIRE - WHITE WINE**

### **40 Muscadet de Sevre et Maine sur Lie - 2009 £ 19.75**

An elegant, fruity dry white wine. Crisp with light refreshing acidity. The moderate alcohol levels of Muscadet (always under 12%) allows them to complement many types of dishes without overwhelming them. The light, crisp acidity can "cut through" rich, creamy dishes. Great with oysters, lobster, shrimp and mullet. Alc. 12.0%

### **41 Sancerre Domaine Daulny - 2009 £ 28.50**

Top Sancerre like this is hard to beat, a blend of old vines and unique limestone-rich Kimmeridgean clay terroir, giving a mouth watering experience, worthy of the finest fare. Restrained yet richly intense nettley and ripe lemon fruit aromas. The palate is both fairly full with fleshy citrus fruit flavours balanced by crunchy pebble-like acidity. Alc. 12.5%

### **42 Pouilly Fumé - 2009 £ 34.00**

Domaine de Berthiers - A quality dry white wine exclusively from vineyards in the upper Loire with a refreshing almost mouth-watering dryness, which is so characteristic of the Sauvignon Blanc grape. Alc. 12.5%

## **RHÔNE - RED WINE**

### **50 Côte du Rhône - 2008\* £ 19.75**

Les Privilèges des Vignerons - A fine example of what is possible when organically grown grapes and intelligent wine making combine. An elegant, medium-bodied wine, which will complement game and rich meat dishes. Alc. 13.0%

**51 Vacqueyras - 2009**

**£ 29.50**

Domaine de Verquieres - Wonderful wine from the pretty little village of Vacqueyras. Made from Grenache and Syrah this full-bodied wine has underlying powerful fruit from the Grenache with gentle spice from the Syrah. These wines are perfect for hearty meat stews and herb-based dishes. Alc. 13.5%

**52 Chateauneuf-du-Pape - 2009**

**£ 39.50**

Domaine de Ramparts. A powerful wine made with Grenache Syrah and Mourvedre at the heart of this blend. Rich and velvety, with prominent red fruits and spice and a background of liquorice. A great choice for rich, full-flavoured game dishes. Alc. 14.0%

**ALSACE - WHITE WINE**

**60 Pfaffenheim Pinot Gris – 2008**

**£ 24.00**

This heady white wine can be substituted for a red with meat dishes, a plate of cold meat, country pâté, roasts, game and poultry. It also goes very well with fish in sauce, smoked fish or lobster. Alc 13.5%

**61 Pfaffenheim Gewurztraminer - 2009**

**£ 26.00**

Full of character and personality. Intense and complex nose. Spicy, sweet, exotic, perfumed fruit - pineapple, lychees, hints of wax, balanced by mouth-watering acidity. Alc 13.5%

## **GERMANY - WHITE WINE**

**62 Oppenheimer Krötenbrunnen - 2009 \*      £ 19.75**

Rheinhessen Spatlese – A delicious, medium sweet wine showing the richness of the late picked grapes. Alc. 9.0%

**63 Dr Loosen Riesling “L” Qba - 2009      £ 26.00**

Typical high quality Mosel Riesling, demonstrating the wonderful harmony and purity of fruit and acidity, that makes Riesling arguably the finest white wine grape in the world. Smoked fish and salty cheeses are classic pairings. Alc. 8.5%

**64 Oppenheimer Herrenberg Auslese - 2007      £ 32.00**

An opulent wine. Complex evolving aromas of spice, marmalade and super-ripe tropical fruit carry on to the palate, with excellent acidity to balance. Alc 8.5%

## **ENGLAND - WHITE WINE**

**69 Sharpham Dart Valley Reserve - 2009      £ 24.00**

From the Sharpham vineyard in Totnes Devon. The grape varieties are Madeleine Angevin, Baccus and Phoenix. Lovely fruit aromas with supple delicate flavours and a just off-dry style resulting in a wine ideal for drinking with food. Alc. 11.5%

## **ITALY - WHITE WINE**

**70 Pinot Grigio Ca Solera - 2010\* £ 19.75**

This wine is made entirely from Pinot Grigio grapes sourced in Grave Del Friuli. It is dry, crisp and refreshing with good depth and concentration. Alc. 11.5%

**71 Soave Classico Costeggiola - 2008 £ 24.00**

Sourced from the most mature vines on the Costeggiola estate, the grapes are harvested by hand, with picking late in the season to achieve optimum ripeness. A dry and slightly perfumed wine, ideal with smoked seafood, shellfish, goat's cheese or mild curry dishes. Alc. 11.5%

## **ITALY - RED WINE**

**75 Montepulziano d'Abruzzo - 2009 £ 19.75**

Brilliant ruby red in colour, full of fruit with soft tannins and a mellow finish. Alc. 12.0%

**76 Valpolicella Classico - 2009 £ 29.00**

This wine is exclusively produced from grapes coming from the fully organic Guerrieri Rizzardi vineyards. A hint of oak on the nose, morello cherry and leather notes on the palate. This well made wine shows what is possible with the use of modern wine-making techniques. Alc. 12.0%

**77 Chianti Reserva Docg - 2008 £ 33.00**

Cantina di Moltalcino – Chianti as it should! Ripe Sangiovese grapes are picked and vinified by leaving the grape skins to macerate for 12-14 days. The wine is then refined by placing it in Slovenian oak casks for 12 months. Alc. 13.0%

### **PORTUGAL - RED WINE**

**80 Tuella Douro - 2008 £ 26.00**

From the Symington Family estates, a deep plummy red with ripe black fruit characteristics, herbs and spices and unmistakable aromas of fresh earth - typical of good wines from the Douro valley. "This wine looks like port in the glass...a real concentrated finish. Alc. 13.0%

### **SPAIN - WHITE WINE**

**81 Rioja Vega Blanco - 2010 £ 19.75**

Made from Viura grapes. Pale yellow with green hues. To the nose it brings fruity, intense varietal aromas. Balanced, fresh and lively in the mouth, with tangy notes. Alc. 13.0%

### **SPAIN - RED WINE**

**85 Rioja Vega 'Muerza' - Crianza – 2008\* £ 23.00**

**86 Rioja Vega 'Muerza' - Crianza Magnum £ 44.00**

Made from Tempranillo, Mazuelo and Garnacha grapes. Picked at their optimal ripeness, careful ageing for twelve months in oak casks, followed by at least a further six months in the bottle. The result is a complex wine, rich in aromas and flavours. Clean, bright ruby red with aromas of vanilla, toast and spices. Well-structured, meaty and balanced in the mouth. Alc. 13.5%

**87 Bodegas Navarro Lopez - Old Vine Tempranillo –  
Gran Reserva - 2004 £ 28.00**

A Gran Reserva red wine of great distinction made from 100% Tempranillo. Following a slow fermentation at a controlled temperature in stainless steel tanks, the wine is aged 24 months in French(60%) and American(40%) oak barriques. Garnet red colour with pale rim. Cherry, toasted vanilla nose. Very full with mature strawberry fruits combined with almonds and spice on the palate, great depth and intensity of flavours leaving a very appealing, enduring and nutty aftertaste. Alc. 13.0%

**88 Rioja Vega Reserva - 2006 £ 33.00**

One of the most famous red wine growing areas, produces this full-bodied wine, packed with plummy flavours, lots of body and character, yet soft and velvety. Wine with a tremendous bouquet, beautifully balanced. Alc. 13.5%

**SPAIN - ROSÉ WINE**

**89 Rioja Vega Rosado - 2009 £ 22.00**

Made from Garnacha grapes. Intense raspberry pink, fresh and bright. To the nose it brings clean, honest, intense varietal aromas, with fruity notes. Very well balanced, lively and cheerful. Alc. 12.5%

## **AUSTRALIAN - WHITE WINE**

**90 AE - Semillon Chardonnay - 2010 £ 19.75**

From South Eastern Australia this delightful crisp and fruity wine is a result of a blend of Trophy Winning Semillon and oak-matured Chardonnay to produce a well balanced full flavoured wine. Alc. 13.0%

**91 Shadow's Run Unwooded Chardonnay – 2010 £ 27.00**

From this boutique winery in McLaren Vale, comes this fresh Chardonnay. The fruit speaks for itself with a soft and rich mouthfeel, showing golden peach, ripe pear and honeydew melon flavours, drawn together with a zesty citrus finish. Alc. 13.0%

**92 Mitchells Watervale Riesling – 2008 £ 27.50**

From the Clare valley. Intense aromatic Riesling fruit flavours are the hallmarks of this wine. It has a fine dry palate with a crisp acidity and a long lingering fruit finish. Alc. 13.5 %

**93 Mitchells Semillon - 2006 £ 29.00**

A beautiful green gold colour with an aroma of lemons and butter. On the palate there is a richness and depth of fruit, balanced by tasty oak, and mouth watering acidity. Alc. 13.0%

## **AUSTRALIAN - RED WINE**

**95 Karri Oak Estate Cabernet Merlot - 2008 £ 24.00**

From Western Australia this is a wine with distinctive ripe blackcurrant and plum aromas. Made from a blend of approximately 80% Cabernet and 20% Merlot from selected low-yielding vineyard blocks. The grapes are separately cool fermented and left to settle for at least 6 month before blending. A light touch of oak is used in this wine to add complexity and control the structure of the tannins. Alc. 14.0%

**96 Simon Hackett Old Vine Grenache - 2008 £ 28.00**

Soft, luscious summer fruit flavours pack this rich red wine. Made in small quantities, a powerful example of Mr Hackett's wine-making genius. Alc. 14.0%

**97 Mitchells Peppertree Shiraz - 2007 £ 29.00**

Andrew Mitchell in the Clare Valley is a perfectionist and this is exactly the style he expects from his Shiraz. Huge fruit richness and intense flavour with good backbone and structure. Alc 14.5%

**98 Simon Hackett Anthony's Reserve Shiraz - 2002 £ 38.50**

Intense plum, spicy strawberry, lemon and eucalyptus jump out of the glass. Beneath there are aromas of toasty vanilla and smoky bacon. Ripe plum and blackcurrant flavours are apparent throughout the palate. This is Australian wine at it's very best. Alc. 14.0%

**NEW ZEALAND - WHITE WINE**

**100 C J Pask Sauvignon Blanc - 2009\* £ 27.00**

Chris Pask and Kate Radburn produce some of the best wines in Hawkes Bay. Tropical fruit flavours characterise this harmonious easy drinking Sauvignon. Very fresh, lively and fruity. Alc. 13.0%

**101 Lake Chalice Pinot Gris - 2007 £ 29.00**

Fully dry but finely balanced, with a scented bouquet of pears and spices, Fresh crisp flavours combine well with the wine's slightly oily texture. Alc. 13.0%

## **NEW ZEALAND - RED WINE**

### **105 Lake Chalice Pinot Noir - 2009 £ 29.00**

This hand-crafted wine from Marlborough has a ruby colour, with classic aromas of cherry and plum, hints of raspberry and rich savoury undertones of spicy oak. Medium bodied, with a soft, full palate, well balanced acidity, supple tannins and flavours of red plum and cherry that linger. Alc. 13.5%

### **106 C J Pask Merlot - 2007 £ 33.00**

From Hawkes Bay, deep-coloured and deep-flavoured, it has a beautiful nose of cherry and ripe currant fruit with spice and dark chocolate. Alc. 13.5%

## **SOUTH AFRICA - WHITE WINE**

### **110 Good Hope Vineyards Chenin Blanc - 2009 £ 24.00**

Wines of Good Hope, Stellenbosch. Pale yellow with lots of exotic flavours. Full flavour in the mouth with enticing freshness. An excellent Chenin Blanc with lots of class. Alc. 13.5%

### **111 Bon Courage Chardonnay – 2010\* £ 26.00**

The Bon Courage Estate in Breede River run by Jaques Bruiere and his sons are winning awards all over South Africa. The influence of the French oak gives this wine an appealing round texture and great complexity. A lovely harmony is formed by a hint of citrus and vanilla that makes it an elegant wine. Lime gold colour indicates some mature notes which are highlighted in big, full nose where peach and citrus combine to give super complexity. Big mouth packed with flavours including grapefruit, lime and lees. This wine is delicious with fish in a creamy sauce, sushi, Thai dishes, pate and turkey. Alc. 12.5%

## **CHILE - RED WINE**
