For your comfort and that of our others guests we kindly ask that all dog-owners staying in our hotels follow these guidelines;

- You take full responsibility for your dog
- Your dog should be well behaved and kept on a lead when in the public areas of the hotel
- You are fully responsible for cleaning up after your dog when in our grounds and surrounding areas
- You are fully responsible for any noise disruption caused by your dog and any damage caused by your dog will be charged
- Please show consideration to the hotel furnishings and make sure your dog is not allowed on the chairs nor the bed in your room. If you would like a dog bed and haven't brought your own, we will be happy to provide this for you
- We request no more than two dogs per room
- Dogs are not permitted in our restaurants and some bar/lounge areas. If you wish to be with your dog whilst eating, we have areas

- in the hotel where you can sit with your dog. Please ask the Manager or the Reception Team
- Please use the door hanger provided whilst your dog is in your bedroom to ensure staff are aware and do not disturb
- If your room needs extra cleaning or maintenance after your stay due to your dog, then we reserve the rights to charge this as an extra cost to your bill
- Dog owners must show consideration to other guests throughout their stay and continuous barking and illbehaved dogs will not be tolerated
- Dogs must not be left in your hotel bedroom if you are planning on venturing outside of the hotel. If your dog is alone and distressed and we cannot get hold of you then this can be an issue
- Please stop by the reception and ask for a dog towel after a muddy or wet walk before heading to your room
